Marie-Louise Essink-Bot (1960 – 2016)

The EUPHA community is deeply saddened to learn of the tragic loss of Scientific Committee member Professor Marie-Louise Essink-Bot. She has contributed to four presentations in the conference programme.

Marie-Louise Essink-Bot was professor of Public Health, and based at the Department of Public Health of the Academic Medical Centre at the University of Amsterdam, the Netherlands. She played a key role in research and teaching regarding equity in health care.



From her close colleagues in Amsterdam we share the message below:

It is with a very heavy heart that we have to inform you that our colleague Marie-Louise Essink-Bot tragically passed away in an accident while on holiday in the Pyrenees in France. The sudden loss of such a fine colleague who has dedicated her life to help improve the health of vulnerable populations is beyond our comprehension.

It is truly a very sad and difficult moment for all of us here. We extend our deepest sympathies and condolences to her husband and three children.

May her soul rest in peace.
