Undocumented migrant women's access to sexual and reproductive health services in European countries seen through a human rights lens

Across Europe a series of legal and policy barriers combine with a range of practical obstacles to severely restrict undocumented migrant women's access to sexual and reproductive health services resulting in lack of respect for their fundamental human rights.

This workshop will highlight the international human rights obligations imposed on European countries to protect undocumented migrant women's access to health care and highlight specific examples of failures to do so in selected European countries and how these failures directly and negatively impact undocumented migrant women's health and lives.
